When me and my wife read this verse during our quiet time, she said how special this is, because it feels to her as if this is also what the Lord has done in *establishing* Disciples Go Ministries.

Realizing this, I felt a deep sense of thankfulness, that the Lord is able to use us to be such a *support network* to His labourers, who many times are *afflicted and suffering*.

We are thankful to see how many of them are finding *refuge* in Him as they become part of this network of disciple-makers.

It is the greatest privilege to see them grow in *faith* and in bearing lasting *fruit*, as we journey together and support each other in *making disciples*, who *make disciples*!

Up till now *Twenty* disciple-makers from across *Africa* have become part of this network.

Together most of them have grown to become disciple-making leaders in their areas, focused on making disciples as well as developing strong disciple-making teams

Taking all of their disciple-making efforts into account, 59 People of Peace have been found, who has opened up their groups of people to the Gospel, which has led to the establishment of Discovery Bible Study groups amongst all of them.

Many of these groups have also *multiplied* into new groups of people discovering God for themselves and becoming disciples of Jesus!

This speaks of the impact these brothers and sisters are making into *lostness* and we thank God for doing all of this, as these Kingdom workers are finding *refuge* in what He has *established*...
