



Not looking at the *situations*, looking among the *nations*!

As we are getting ready to vote for a new government here in South-Africa, the conversations in general, tend to remind you a lot about the conversation between the prophet Habakkuk and the Lord in Habakkuk 1:1-5.

Habakkuk is the only book in the Bible that starts with a *complaint*. The prophet Habakkuk is complaining to the Lord about the *situation* he and his people are finding themselves in, as it seems that injustice and violence have become the order of the day (cf. verse 2-4).

The Lord's answer to Habakkuk's complaint is striking: **Stop looking at the *situations*, look among the *nations*!** "For I am doing a work in your days that you would not believe if told" (verse 5).

Will our faith make us believe this also for *our days*?

So that, rather than complaining, we will be willing to join God in what He is doing among the nations, in *our days* as well?

What we read about in this Newsletter gives testimony to the fact that God is at work in doing these *extraordinary things* through the most "*ordinary people*", who is willing to trust Him in this...

Finding Prepared People among the nations



A disciple-maker affiliated with DGM, went on a prayer walk recently in his community. During the prayer walk the opportunity arose to pray over two people, who came across his path. When he asked them if they would like to discover who this God is who loves them, a lady who listened in on the conversation, came running towards them. She pleaded with them to be part of this journey of discovery and they established a date and a time that will suite all of them to start doing Discovery Bible Study.

When the Disciple-maker returned on that day to facilitate the Bible Study, only she was there. When he asked her what she is struggling with, she shared that she is struggling with alcohol-addiction and that every time she had too much to drink, she makes mistakes, which was destroying her relationship with her boyfriend.

The disciple-maker decided to pray for her and as soon as he ended his prayer, a man stood in front of them, wanting to confess his own sin when it came to the misuse of alcohol. And then the lady shared with the disciple-maker that this man was her boyfriend. They invited him to become part of their Bible study group to which he responded positively.

Since then, both of these people have seen a breakthrough in their struggle with alcohol and as God is doing this by drawing them closer to Himself, they are also growing closer in their relationship with each other. The Lord is making everything new, as He said He would!

Another man who is part of their network, has now also joined their Discovery Group.

Look among the nations! God is doing a work in preparing people, who is ready to be disciplined and to open up new groups of people to His gospel of salvation!

We are seeing how the Lord is doing the same thing in different places and among different *nations* in our country, as the team in **Kwa-Zulu Natal** is also finding more and more *Prepared People of Peace* in their communities.

These people are not just open to the gospel, but also willing to introduce their friends and families to the gospel.

This is giving the disciple-makers an opportunity to establish Discovery Bible Study groups amongst them, through which the Lord is doing a work of great transformation in their lives.
