Two disciple-makers, who forms part of a disciple-making team in Uganda, was sent by the Lord of the harvest to an unreached people group in Uganda.

They experienced how the Lord went before them and how He connected them to the people He had been preparing for them in advance.

One of these people was Mariko, the Commander of a notorious gang of criminals called "The Warriors".

When Mariko got saved, he turned out to be the *Person* of *Peace*, as he took the two disciple-makers to every homestead in their village, to share the gospel. This just shows you how *Luke 10* is a strategy that cannot fail, if you work by faith, through love!

Since then, *Discovery Bible*Study Groups been established, in order to get all the receptive people to be taught by God, while the disciple-makers will focus on developing the "inside-leaders" in these groups, like our brother Mariko.

Helping him become a leader in advancing the Kingdom, where he once was a leader in criminal activities!

learned when they were


first introduced to making disciples in this way.

One of the Habits replicating disciple example, is "Extra-Ordinary prayer", which means to add extra to our ordinary prayerlife. As we have been sharing practical ways in which to do that, it has been amazing to see how they have put it into practice, with their teams.

For example disciple-maker, Sandra Perumal from Gingindlovu and her team have each "adopted" a street in their community to do weekly "*prayer walk*s" in.

Another disciple-making leader from Malawi have also shared with us how one of his Discovery Bible Study groups have been doing "allnight" prayer once a month, not for their own selfish desires to be met, but for the sole purpose of *making* disciples!



After establishing a very fruitful access ministry amongst unemployed woman in her community, a disciple-maker from Pretoria felt urged to also start reaching out in the same way to unemployed men in her community.

Her vision was to start a two-weekly program to train these men in doing carpentry, with the goal of finding *people of peace* amongst the men who will sign up to learn this valuable skill.

After being unsuccessful at first in finding someone who can train these men in carpentry, the Lord provided through connecting her with another skilful disciplemaker who are also part of the broader network.

During the month of September, they started joining hands in making this *access-ministry* possible and we trust that the Lord will use this initiative to connect them with the *people* of peace who will open up new groups of people for the Gospel!
