UGANDA — UNREACHED REACHING THE UNREACHED

The state of disciple making movement in Uganda is growing speedily from one disciple to both a disciple making movement and church planting movement especially among the unreached people groups of Karamoja in Uganda, Turkana and Maasai in Kenya. As you remember in the month of September 2025, the Lord led us to Kotido in the Karamoja region, where we found a *person of peace*, called *Marico*, who together with his family of 8 people, gave their lives to Jesus Christ. Marico, at that stage was a commander of a band of criminals called “*the warriors*”, but when he gave his life to Jesus, he immediately put his obedience into practice by leading his fellow *warriors* to Jesus Christ. Right now Marico and his team of disciples have sparked a movement of disciple makers across the region and in Western Kenya, Turkana and Maasai.

Currently in Karamoja, there are 42 Movement Churches and 18 Discovery Bible Studies that are transitioning into becoming Movement churches by mid-May. The number of disciples baptised since last year by all our networks are more than a thousand now. The current disciple making in Kenya where Marico and his team has reached out to last year, now stands at 7 disciple-making Churches that has been planted and 8 Discovery Bible Study groups that are transitioning into becoming Movement Churches like these. The number of disciples baptised in Kenya stands at 86. The number of Movement churches in Mbale, Bulambuli and Namutumba is 36 with 21 Discovery Bible Study Groups also transitioning in to Movement churches soon.

Projects in Kotido like “*Farming God's way*” and a *Carpentry training centre* that has been established, have turned out to be valuable *access ministries* that have opened the door for more “*warriors*” to come to Jesus Christ.

We were personally touched when a sub county Chief approached us after hearing that we were busy with these 2 projects in his region and asked if we could accommodate more “*warriors*” in these initiatives, after they have come to surrender their weapons at the State Authorities, because of surrendering their lives to Christ.

Keep praying for the *Labourers* to continue being faithful and obedient to the Lord of the *harvest!*

MALAWIAN DISCIPLE-MAKERS PLAYING THEIR PART

As he now lives a life that attracts people, they come to him for spiritual guidance and prayers. This is true transformation, from being a Muslim to becoming a disciple maker in Christ Jesus our Lord. We give Him all the Glory! (Erick Naboti – Malawian Coordinator)



ON HOME SOIL – CHILDREN TURNING INTO GOOD SOIL

One of the most *faithful* and *fruitful* disciple-makers in our network is a lady called *Zanelle* who lives in a settlement called *Luckau, Limpopo*.

You will struggle to find anyone who will be more faithful in immediately using what she has learned and putting it into practice.

This past month we had the privilege of again travelling to her to further train her and her team in making disciples.

The training session was all about how to *share our Testimonies* and do a *Gospel presentation* in less than two minutes, as a means of *engaging with the lost* and finding *people of peace*.

. Within a day she got the children from her children ministry together and started training them to do the same and then she took a step further by going out into the streets with these children to give them opportunity to immediately put into practice what they have learned.

As these children were sharing with great boldness what God has done in their lives, their testimonies touched the hearts of many which led to the establishment of numerous *Discovery Bible Study*-groups with all the *receptive* people.

Truly, the Lord does not give us a “*green*” harvest to work with, the only thing needed is more of these willing labourers, like Zanelle and her team of children!

MOBILIZING MORE DISCIPLE-MAKERS IN SOUTH-AFRICA, *TO FLOOD AFRICA!*

During the past month we had the privilege of training people in numerous places to become *multiplying disciples*.

From concluding a seven-week training with a Congolese and Burundian Church in the Central part of Pretoria, to a whole week training with all the students and staff-members of Flock House Ministries in the Northern part of our Capital.

We also had the privilege of traveling far north into Limpopo and deep into the mountains of Mpumalanga, to train groups of people in *making disciples* the DMM way.

Our goal is to *throw out the net* as wide as possible, to find those who will be most *faithful* and *fruitful* in putting into practice what they have learned.

It is with these "*mustard seeds*" that we want to *labour* further with and see how God makes them become like *forests* for His Kingdom's sake! (cf. Mat. 13:31-33)

And by His grace we are seeing how that is bearing fruit and making His Kingdom grow exponentially, through these *multiplying disciple-makers!*

As we see this being the *strategy of Jesus*, we realize that it cannot *fail* if it is done by *faith*, through *love!*

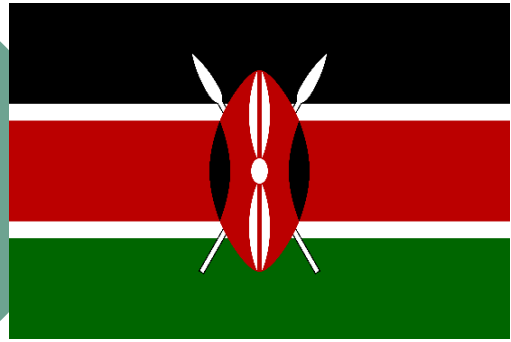
This young man, Naldo Kent (front page photo) accompanied us to the disciple-making trainings in Limpopo and Mpumalanga, where he was so touched and encouraged by what he heard that he

immediately put into practice what he learned when he came home. Experiencing how God is laying a certain community on his heart, he started reaching out to that community through weekly *prayer walks*. Through this initiative God led him to a very *receptive person* at a local food truck stand, who was not just *hungry* for food, but for the Word of God and therefore excited to start a weekly *Discovery Bible Study* - meeting with Naldo and all his friends who he wanted to invite to discover God with them.

God truly does not give us a *green harvest* to work with, but a ready and plentiful one! If, like Naldo, we will also just be willing to “Go”, then we will also “*know*” ...

It is these types of “*Practitioners*” like Naldo that we are seeking, because that is where *Movement* happens!

 - We also plan to visit all the disciple-makers who is part of our network in Zambia and Malawi to further strengthen and equip them and their teams of disciple-makers. As plans are taking shape the Lord is also opening more doors to new and receptive areas along the way, where we will have the opportunity to train up more disciple-makers for Him! We trust that He will use all these efforts, in-spite of us!
