

Recently we've seen how disciple-makers from Uganda is making disciples among unreached people groups in their country, who themselves has now started overflowing into Kenya to go and make disciple-makers amongst an unreached people group there as well.

It can only be a move of the Spirit, because it is far too big for us to comprehend or accomplish.

It definitely does not come without it's challenges,

every grain of wheat has to fall into the ground and die first, before it can bear much fruit.

But In spite of it all, every disciple-maker will tell you how it is worth it and how they can't see themselves doing anything else, since there is nothing *greater* than fulfilling the *Great Commission!*

We are so very thankful and humbled to see how the Lord is *able* to use us, to do so much more than we could ask or imagine, through His power that is at work within very *ordinary people* like ourselves. And He started off the year by opening up a door for us to *Burundi*, where we have received an opportunity to train a Church leader who is serious about being a disciple-maker and equipping His people to fulfil the Great Commission as well.

Rwanda becoming a sustainable movement

"You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last..." (John 15:16)

The team in Rwanda have worked tirelessly through the end of last year and the beginning of this one to train and mobilize more disciple-makers in various regions as well as to train leaders in order to see it become a sustainable movement.

A couple of weekends back they had an opportunity to gather with some key leaders which they are developing in these different regions. Their goal was to equip and strengthen them, but they themselves were strengthened and encouraged by what they found. Seeing how these labourers had made

disciples, who are making disciples themselves, especially amongst the youth. They were also encouraged when they saw the servanthood mentality which was present amongst these leaders. Some of them even willing to give what they had as well as raising money amongst their groups, in order to pay the school fees for lesser privileged children in the communities. This has given them a reason for being in the community and it has served to win the trust and in some cases even the hearts of the people in the community for Jesus!

It was also such a privilege for me (Giepie) to partner with our Co-ordinator in Rwanda to train a group of students from a University in Rwanda via Zoom. The session was about the importance of *Discovery* as a tool to make disciples, that can reproduce and it was a joy to see how far she has come with these students and how serious they are in fulfilling the Great Commission!

May the Good work in training more workers for the harvest, continue in that strategically important African Country! Lord help us!


Going further- *together!*



Disciple-making training


The Lord worked with these brothers, by confirming His words through signs and wonders and demonstrating to these people how near His kingdom have truly come to them.
